

## **Instructions for Hearings before Judge Randal S. Mashburn**

Pursuant to Administrative Order 20-5, no in-person hearings are currently being conducted for bankruptcy matters in the Middle District of Tennessee. Matters scheduled before Judge Mashburn will be handled as follows:

1. All matters set on the regular Wednesday consolidated Chapter 13 hearing docket, as well as any Columbia and Cookeville dockets, will be heard in accordance with Administrative Order 20-5, which includes the following call-in information:

2. Unless otherwise indicated, for all non-Chapter 13 matters – including hearings set on the regular Tuesday 7/11 motion docket, as well as any specially set hearings and any pretrial conferences, status conferences, or matters relating to an adversary proceeding before Judge Mashburn, instructions regarding telephonic or video hearings will sometimes be set forth in a docket order relating to the specific case in advance of the scheduled time. If there is nothing in the court docket reflecting special instructions for a particular case, the matter will be heard telephonically, using the following call-in information:

3. Pursuant to Administrative Order 20-5, matters before Judge Mashburn that were previously set for 9:00 a.m. on the regular Tuesday motion docket will generally instead be heard at 9:30 a.m.

4. With regard to motions for relief from stay where no response was timely filed, no hearing will be conducted. In that situation, an appropriate order should be submitted in accordance with LBR 4001-1(e).
