If no objections are timely filed, the court will act on the fee application and approve the trustee's compensation and expenses, and disbursements will be made as proposed pursuant to FRBP 3009 without further order of the Court.

YOUR RIGHTS MAY BE AFFECTED. Absent timely response, the court will approve the trustee's compensation and expenses and the pending fee application and disbursements will be made as proposed. If you do not want the court to grant the motion or the trustee to make the disbursements as proposed, then on or before **Oct 16, 2015** , you or your attorney must:
